

#### **ARTICLE 1. Organization**

The 2025 DHOFAR CLASSIC, the 1st edition of the event, is organised by the Oman Cycling Association and supported by Dhofar Municipality and in accordance with the regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI).

It will take place on Saturday, September 6th, 2025.

#### **ARTICLE 2. Type of Event**

The event is reserved to riders from the Elite Men's Category.

It is registered in the Asia Tour calendar with a 1.2 classification, and it will give points to the UCI's classifications, in accordance with articles 2.10.001 to 2.10.008 of the UCI regulations.

- · Points are awarded as follows to the first 10 finishers:
  - 40, 30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5, 3, 3, 3 Points

#### **ARTICLE 3. Participation**

In accordance with article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the event is open to:

- UCI ProTeams
- UCI continental teams
- UCI cyclo-cross professional teams
- · National teams
- Regional and club teams

In accordance with article 2.2.003 of the UCI regulations, the number of cyclists per team is restricted to a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6.

#### **ARTICLE 4. Race Headquarters**

The race headquarters will be open on Friday 5, 2025 from 4pm. to 10pm. at the hotel where accommodation is. Sport directors are requested to confirm their starters and collect their race numbers (bibs) at the race headquarters on September 6, 2025, from 5pm to 6:30 pm. The team manager's meeting, in the presence of the president of the commissaires' panel, members of organization, members of commissaires' panel and regulators is scheduled for 7pm.

#### **ARTICLE 5. Radio-Tour**

Radio tour will be broadcasted in English. The frequency will be given at the team manager meeting.

































#### ARTICLE 6. Neutral Technical Support

Two neutral technical support cars will be provided by Muscat Bikes and Adventures Box.

#### ARTICLE 7. Finishing Deadlines

Riders whose finishing time is more than 12% greater than the winner's time shall be excluded from the classification.

The Commissaires' Panel may extend the time limit in the event of exceptional circumstances, after consultation with the organiser.

#### **ARTICLE 8. Classification**

The individual time classification shall be established based on the order of arrival at the finish line.

#### **ARTICLE 11. Protocol Ceremony**

The following riders must present themselves at the protocol ceremony:

• The first three riders in the race.

#### **ARTICLE 12. Penalties**

Penalties are in accordance with the UCI regulations.

#### **ARTICLE 13. The Environment**

The organizer sets up collection areas specifically designated to recover waste. Riders must dispose of their waste, water bottles, or any other object only in these specially equipped

Riders and followers must act responsibly with regard to the environment at all times and respect the legal provisions in force.

#### ARTICLE 14. Challenge – Exclusion

14.1 OCA considers the preservation of its image, reputation, and that of its event of utmost importance. It reserves the right to refuse participation in-or exclude from-the event any team or team member whose presence may seriously damage the image and/or reputation of OCA and/or the event.

14.2 OCA may also exclude any team or team member for the following reasons:

- Breach of the event's rules, including internal rules (e.g., accommodation regulations)
- Serious breach of Sultanate of Oman law
- · Acts of vandalism, on or off the course
- Indecent attire or inappropriate behaviour
- Any act liable to damage the image or reputation of the organizer and/or of the Dhofar Classic

#### **ARTICLE 1. Organization**

The 5th edition of the Tour of Salalah is organized in accordance with the regulations of the Inter- national Cycling Union (UCI). The tour is organized by Oman Cycling Association and supported by Dhofar Municipality, The tour consists of 4 stages from September 07, 2025 to September 10, 2025. The organization's address is: Oman Cycling Association P.O. Box 211 -MUSCAT 100

#### **ARTICLE 2. Type of event**

The event is reserved to riders from the Elite Men's Category. It is registered on the UCI calendar in 2.2 classification, and it will give points to the UCI's classifications, in accordance with the articles 2.10.008 of the UCI regulations concerning stages races.

Points are awarded as follows:

- The first 10 finishers in the final General Classification by Time:
  - 40, 30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5, 3, 3, 3 Points
- The first 3 finishers on each stage:
  - 7, 3 and 1 Points
- Daily leader of the General Classification by time
  - 1 Point

#### **ARTICLE 3. Participation**

In accordance with article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the event is open to:

- UCI pro teams
- · UCI cyclo-cross pro teams
- · UCI continental teams
- National teams
- · Regional and club teams

In accordance with article 2.2.003 of the UCI regulations, the number of cyclists per team is restricted to a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6.

#### **ARTICLE 4. Headquarter**

The race headquarters will be open on Friday 5, 2025 from 4pm. to 10pm. at the hotel where accommodation is. Sport directors are requested to confirm their starters and collect their race numbers (bibs) at the race headquarters on September 6, 2025, from 5pm to 6:30 pm. The team manager's meeting, in the presence of the president of the commissaires' panel, members of organization, members of commissaires' panel and regulators is scheduled for 7pm.































#### **ARTICLE 5. Radio-Tour**

Radio tour will be broadcasted in English. The frequency will be given at the team manager meeting.

#### **ARTICLE 6. Timekeeping**

The Timekeeping Service, provided by ZAMN Sports Tech ZAMN with the assistance of the Finish Judge, will be responsible for recording the official times. All riders will be equipped with a transponder for the automatic recording of their times. At the end of the final stage, all transponders must be returned to the organizer. A fine of OMR 30 will be charged for any lost transponder.

#### **ARTICLE 7. Neutral technical support**

Two neutral technical support cars will be provided by Muscat Bikes and Adventures Box.

#### **ARTICLE 8. Last 3 kilometers**

In accordance with article 2.6.027 of the UCI regulations. In the event of a fall, tyre puncture or technical issue during the last three kilometers of the stage, the cyclist who was involved in the accident shall be given the time of the group he was with at the time of the accident, and will be given the finish order when crossing the finish line. If the cyclist is not able to cross the finish line due to a fall during the last three kilometers, the cyclist will be awarded last place in the order of entry and will be given the time of the group he was with at the time of the accident.

The rule will not be applied in Stage 2,

#### **ARTICLE 9. Finish Time Limit**

For each stage there is a finish time limit corresponding to the winner's time:

- Stage 1 & 4: 12%
- Stage 2 & 3: 15%

In accordance with UCI Regulations, in exceptional and unforeseen cases, the jury may change the time limit in consultation with the organizer.

#### **ARTICLE 10. Bonuses**

Time bonuses, applied only to the general individual classification, are awarded for all stages according to article 2.6.019 of the UCI regulations. They concern intermediate sprints and stage finishes, and are awarded as follows:

- 3", 2" and 1" will be awarded to the first 3 riders in intermediate sprints;
- 10", 6" and 4" will be awarded to the first 3 riders at stage finishes.

































#### ARTICLE 11. General individual time classification

The general individual time classification is established by adding together the times recorded for each stage, taking bonuses and penalties into consideration.

In the event of a tie, the places achieved for each stage are added up and, as a last resort, the place obtained in the final stage is counted. The leader of the general individual time classification will wear a yellow jersey.

#### **ARTICLE 12. Point classification**

A points classification is established by adding together the points obtained in each stage as well as the intermediate sprints.

Points for the intermediate sprints in each stage will be awarded as follows:

3 -2 and 1 point (s) to the first 3 riders.

At the finish of the stages:

15 -12 -9-7- 6-5-4-3-2 and 1 point(s)to the first 10 riders.

The leader of the points classification will wear a green jersey.

In the event of a tie in the general individual points classification, the following criteria shall be applied in the following order until there is a true ranking.

- 1. number of stage wins;
- 2. number of wins in intermediate sprints:
- 3. general individual time classification.

To be entitled to final general classification prize money, competitors have to complete the entire race within the official time limit.

#### ARTICLE 13. Young rider classification (U23)

The best Young rider classification is the first U23 rider in the general individual classification.

The Leader will wear the White jersey

#### ARTICLE 14. Most aggressive rider classification

The most aggressive rider classification is established by adding together the points obtained in the intermediate sprints and in the climbs classifications of all stages. Points for the intermediate sprints and for the climbs classification in each stage will be awarded as follows:

3 - 2 and 1 point(s) to the first 3 riders.































#### The leader of the classification will wear a silver jersey.

In the event of a tie in the general individual classification for the most aggressive rider, the following criteria shall be applied in order until there is a true ranking.

- 1. number of 1st places in the different intermediate classifications;
- 2. general individual time classification.

To be entitled to final general classification prize money, competitors have to complete the entire race within the official time limit.

#### **ARTICLE 15. Team Classification**

Stage Team Classification In accordance with the UCI regulations, the team classification for each stage is established by adding together the three best individual times from each team. In the event of a tie, the winning team will be determined by adding together the rankings of their three best riders on the stage. If the teams are still tied, they shall be separated by the place obtained by their best rider in the stage classification.

Team general classification The team general classification is established by adding together the three best individual times from each team in every stage. In the event of a tie, the following criteria shall be applied in the following order until the teams are separated:

- 1. the number of first places in the daily team classification;
- 2. the number of second places in the daily team classification. Etc.

If the teams are still tied, they shall be separated by the place obtained by their best rider in the general individual classification.

Any team reduced to fewer than three riders is eliminated from the general team classification.

#### Article 16. Teams car order

One car per team is allowed during the stage, and the order of the cars, in the first stage, will be determined after the drawing of the lot at the team managers meeting. For the following stages, the driving order shall be determined according to the position of the first rider of each team in the general individual time classification (according to art. 2.6.034 UCI Regulations). All convoy vehicles must be on the right side of the road, serving riders on the right only and allowing riders to return to the group or back to team vehicles on the left side of the road. All vehicles in the convoy are subject to the directives of the Jury and the Royal Oman Police.

#### **ARTICLE 18. ANTI DOPING**

UCI anti-doping test regulations are applicable to the event. The anti-doping Control will be sign- posted from the Finishing line of each stage. Riders required for this Control will be listed. Riders required for doping control will be notified by chaperones.

#### **ARTICLE 19. Ceremony Protocol**

After each stage, the following riders must present themselves at the protocol ceremony:

- The first three riders in the race;
- Leader of the General individual time classification:
- Leader of the point classification;
- Leader of the young rider classification;
- Leader of the most aggressive rider classification.

After the final stage of the tour, the following riders must present themselves at the protocol ceremony:

- The first three riders in the race;
- 3 best riders of the general individual time classification;
- Leader of the General individual time classification;
- Leader of the the point classification:
- · Leader of the the young rider classification;
- Leader of the most aggressive rider classification.
- 6 riders and the team manager of the winning team in the general team classification.

The leader in each classification must wear the corresponding leader jersey. If a rider is first in several classifications, the order of priority in which the jerseys will be worn is as follows:

- 1. general individual time classification;
- 2. general points classification;
- 3. young rider classification;
- 4. most aggressive rider classification.

#### **ARTICLE 20. Penalties**

Penalties are in accordance with the UCI regulations.

#### **ARTICLE 21. The Environment**

The organizer sets up collection areas specifically designated to recover waste. Riders must dispose of their waste, water bottles, or any other object only in these specially equipped areas.

Riders and followers must act responsibly with regard to the environment at all times and respect the legal provisions in force.































#### **ARTICLE 22. Challenge – Exclusion**

14.1 OCA considers the preservation of its image, reputation, and that of its event of utmost importance. It reserves the right to refuse participation in-or exclude from-the event any team or team member whose presence may seriously damage the image and/or reputation of OCA and/or the event.

**14.2** OCA may also exclude any team or team member for the following reasons:

- Breach of the event's rules, including internal rules (e.g., accommodation regulations)
- Serious breach of Sultanate of Oman law
- Acts of vandalism, on or off the course
- Indecent attire or inappropriate behaviour
- Any act liable to damage the image or reputation of the organizer and/or of the Dhofar Classic

To promote the Dhofar Classic, each team and rider acknowledges that participation grants the organiser and its beneficiaries the right to reproduce and display, without compensation,
